A. LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 14-O-06 ADOPTING THE POLICE GENERAL ORDER MANUAL

This legislative resolution has been withdrawn. Pursuant to Section 2-205 of the Town Code, any amendments of the General Operating Rules and Regulations instituted by the Chief of Police pursuant to Section 2-207 of the Code shall be forwarded by the Chief to the Council for approval.
