AMENDED LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 11-0-06

Resolution and Ordinance of the Town of University Park, to enact Article 1, Section 2-115 of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of University Park, Maryland, to set compensation of the Mayor ~~[and Council]~~.

WHEREAS, Section 303 of the Charter of the Town of University Park authorizes the Mayor and Council to receive such compensation for their services as they may, by ordinance, establish, provided that said salary or compensation of a sitting Mayor or Councilmember may not be increased during their term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the public interest to set compensation for the Mayor ~~[and Council]~~ as authorized by Section 303 of the Charter.

Section 1: NOW THEREFORE be it resolved and ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of University Park that Chapter 2 "Administration", Article 1 "General Administration", Section 2-115 "Compensation of THE Mayor ~~[and Council]~~", of the Code of the Town of University Park be enacted as follows:

SECTION 2-115. COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR ~~[AND COUNCIL]~~.

~~(A) [COMMENCING WITH OFFICIALS ELECTED IN OR AFTER MAY, 2012, THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:]~~

(A)[~~THE~~] A MAYOR ELECTED OR APPOINTED TO A TERM COMMENCING IN OR AFTER MAY, 2012 SHALL RECEIVE AS COMPENSATION \$[~~10,500.00~~] 15,000.00 PER YEAR, PAYABLE AS SALARY ON A MONTHLY BASIS.

~~[EACH COUNCIL MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE AS COMPENSATION \$2,500.00 PER YEAR, PAYABLE AS A SALARY ON A MONTHLY BASIS.]~~

(B) THE MAYOR [~~OR A COUNCILMEMBER~~] MAY DECLINE THE COMPENSATION SET BY THIS PARAGRAPH.

Section 2: Be it further resolved that this resolution shall become effective twenty (20) days after enactment by the Mayor and Common Council of University Park, Maryland.

Section 3: Be it further resolved that a complete and exact copy of this proposed Ordinance shall be posted on the entrance door of the Town Building of University Park, Maryland, for a period of not less than ten (10) days, and a fair summary of this Ordinance shall be published at least once in a newspaper having general circulation in the community.
