Meeting notes

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Agenda

1. 4300 block of Underwood: school pick-up/drop-off, parking, ordinance enforcement

Councilmember Verrill, with the residents of that block of Underwood, prepared a series of recommendations regarding parking zones, speed limits, and crossing guards, which they presented for the committee's consideration. After some preliminary discussion, the committee agreed to take up these recommendations in detail at its next meeting, in February. In the interim, Councilmember Verrill, Chief Baker, and some block residents will work together to review traffic patterns around the school in the morning and afternoon, with an eye toward considering whether changing the flow of traffic could partially alleviate the problems currently experienced at those times.

2. 4000 block of Van Buren: traffic calming

Councilmember Stephen introduced this motion, seconded by Councilmember Verrill:

That the committee recommend that council order a physical calming on that block, such as a speed hump or chicane or some other physical change to the street.

5. Work session on street repaving, major sidewalk and park path repairs, and possible new sidewalk and park path projects

The committee completed its review the comprehensive list of streets/sidewalk/park path issues compiled by the director of public works, and will report the results of its discussion in a memo to the mayor and council as soon as is practicable.
