The Council entered a Work Session to discuss fiscal year 2020 budget. No legislation was enacted during the work session.

- Mr. Schultz asked for a detailed written estimate/report by the end of the week from Mr. Beall and Mr. Sidhu on cost of the streets/sidewalks project.
- Mr. Caskey asked that Mr. Beall prioritize the streets/sidewalks project if the entire project cannot be done at one time.
- After a discussion on possible changes to the Town bus service, Mr. Schultz informed the Council that the Sustainability Committee will receive a report on May 9 from University of Maryland students in the Environmental Science and Policy Program on the transportation program of the Town, mostly on the Town bus.
- Request an update from Northwestern High School on the \$6,000 grant for library computers/printers.
- Mr. Brosch suggested that \$5,000 be added to the budget for an intern for the Mosquito Program.
- Chief Baker agreed to provide information on data storage for body cameras.
