Meeting notes

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Agenda item #1

Mr. Beall and Mayor Carey delivered a presentation on the town's planning regarding sidewalks and streets, in context of the WSSC water-main replacement work now getting underway. The WSSC will compensate the town for the cost of repaving the streets torn up to replace the mains. The amount the town will receive from WSSC is determined by a statutory formula. WSSC's obligation extends only to putting streets back to original condition. The ability to contract with paving crews already in town to do that work creates an opportunity for the town to have additional work done to improve streets and sidewalks in a cost-effective way.

The committee determined to investigate the possibility of touring several sites in town that could be potential locations for repairs or improvements to streets, sidewalks, and park paths.

Additional business

Mayor Carey updated the committee on the search process just getting underway for Chief of Police.
