

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
UNIVERSITY PARK, MARYLAND TO SUPPORT THE ANACOSTIA WATERSHED
SOCIETY APPLICATION FOR A GREEN STREETS GRANT**

WHEREAS, Wells Run, the stream which runs through the center of the Town of University Park, is affected by stormwater runoff by increased local flooding and erosion which creates sediment loads that make their way to the Anacostia River and ultimately to the Chesapeake Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Town of University Park aims to encourage sustainable environmental stewardship through the activities of its Tree Committee, Stream Committee, and Green Team; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Anacostia Watershed Society is to promote environmental sustainability within the Anacostia River watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of University Park and the Anacostia Watershed Society are committed to working together to address stormwater issues and to improve the health of Wells Run, through improving stormwater quality, reducing stormwater quantity, and stabilizing the surrounding riparian area; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Anacostia Watershed Society is part of a larger incremental plan to turn Queens Chapel Road into a Green Street that will be completed by the Town of University Park and its partners through applications for future funding; and

WHEREAS, the Anacostia Watershed Society and the Town of University Park have partnered and collaborated on projects related to stormwater quality improvement and quantity reduction; and


WHEREAS, the Anacostia Watershed Society plans to work closely with the Town of University Park and other local groups to make this project a community asset and environmental success.




